

COVID-19 Vaccination Consent

The Public Health Agency of Sweden recommends vaccination against COVID-19 for children aged 12 years and above. COVID-19 vaccines protect against severe illness and vaccination is voluntary and free of charge.

Regarding consent

You can use this form to notify us as to whether you wish your child to be vaccinated or not. You do so by placing a cross in one of the boxes below and signing the form. If you share custody of your child with another legal guardian, both guardians must sign the form.

To achieve the best effect, your child will be given two doses of vaccine with an interval of a few weeks in between. Your consent applies to both doses.

What happens if I decline the offer?

As your child's guardian, if you decline the offer for your child to be vaccinated, or if you fail to provide your consent, your child cannot be vaccinated.

However, in certain cases, your child may be allowed to decide for themselves whether or not to be vaccinated. In such cases, the vaccinator will perform an individual assessment to determine whether your child is mature enough to give their own consent to be vaccinated. This is known as a "maturity assessment" (*mognadsbedömning*). Maturity assessments are primarily intended for children aged 15 years and above.
